<u>Director's News:</u>

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL:

Now that the weather is getting warmer, please watch your child during arrival and dismissal outside on the front lawn; they should not be climbing the trees, moving the Belgium blocks around, pulling out flowers, rolling down the hill or playing in the "pit". The "pit" is the side of the building that the four-year-old and two-year-old classes use to enter and exit the school. The grass hill is very steep and leads to a cement landing and the brick wall of the school building. This is not an area that the children should be playing.

TUITION:

Just a reminder that Sept 2025 tuition is due by <u>April 15th</u> for the children entering into the 4-year-old program and <u>May 1st</u> for the students entering into the 2- and 3-year-old programs in the Fall. If you have not yet signed up for the upcoming school year and wish to, please contact us immediately. Some classes are already closed.

The tuition schedule for the remainder of the year is as follows:

April - *April tuition is due

*September 2025 tuition due for the students entering the 4-year-old program

May - *May tuition

*Sept. 2025 tuition for students entering the 2- & 3-year-old program

*Summer Program balance due

June- no payment (if you pre-paid in September or when registered)

August - June 2026 tuition due for students returning in the fall.



Gym shoes, *PLEASE*For safety and fun!




LUNCH BUNCH


