Director's News:

SICKNESS

If your child wakes up not feeling well, please DO NOT send your child to school. These symptoms make them very uncomfortable and disturbs their learning and play routines as well as making the other children and teachers susceptible to catching the sickness. **As always, if a child is *throwing up*, has a *fever*, or *diarrhea*; they need to be a MINIMUM of 24 hours non-symptomatic without the use of medicine before they can return.**

Please let us know if your child is home sick with flu, strep throat, pink eye or covid so we can properly disinfect the room and notify others in the class of what symptoms to look for. It is always our goal to keep everyone healthy and safe. In some cases where a fever is not present, please use your best judgement. If your child is coughing and does not properly cover their mouth, has mucus dripping from their nose and is unable to blow it without assistance, please keep your child home until symptoms clear.

PICTURE DAY:

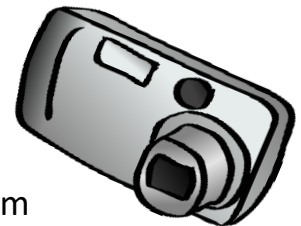
Picture day is scheduled for March 3rd & 4th, more information will follow.

LUNCH BUNCH

Lunch Bunch will be offered each day that class is in session for your child from 11:30-12:30. Lunch Bunch is our extended day program where the children bring their lunch to school and learn how to take care of themselves while eating in a group. This is a great opportunity for the children to socialize and become a little more independent, especially those who may be attending UPK or Kindergarten next year and need to get used to a much longer school day. The cost of the program is \$15/day that your child attends and there is no weekly obligation. We do need your child's form 24hrs prior to the date they attend to make sure there is room.
